- Research support

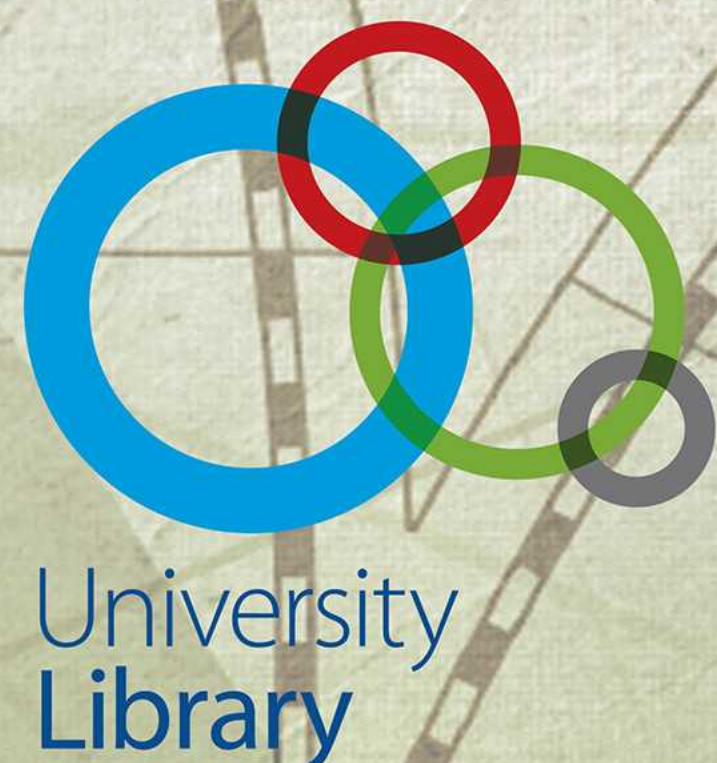
We offer encounters with content
